CHANGE OF GUARD

All India Nationalised Banks Officers' Federation (AINBOF), was formed during 2009 by the eminent leaders led the Bank officers movement in the country, rightly forecasting the Government plans to damage the the fine fabric of Public sector banks and also to look after the welfare of the Officers'

fraternity of all Nationalised Banks exclusively, remaining as a sectoral organization AIBOC.

History will reveal that AINBOF played the vital role in getting the 2nd option for pension, the most cherished achievement for the officers in the form of pension benefits and also consistently raising voice to protect the very presence of PSBs in the country which are solely responsible for the economic sustenance and stability of our great nation.

AINBOF which was always fighting for the cause of the Bank officers demanded Wage revision on the principles of central pay commission which ensures wages on the basis of need and requirement, without linking to the paying capacity and profitability of the Banks which were the stand of all the officers trade unions and the COD also was submitted accordingly.

When the negotiations drifted from the above said principle which was followed in wage fixation of the Government sector, AINBOF went on several agitations for achieving that cause and even approached the courts.

However, AINBOF was forced to come out of AIBOC during January 2021 due to the differing policies adopted at the highest level unminding the larger interests of the members.

With this exit, AINBOF emerged as the second largest trade union for the officers in the Banking Industry with more than 68000 members and the fifth Trade Union for officers in the Banking Sector. IBA, DFS and CLC have been apprised of our position and have already sought to include us in the consultations concerning the bank officers to guard the welfare of the officers serving in the Nationalised Banks.

Our efforts borne fruit when CLC recognized our stand and called us for the reconciliation meeting to defer the March 2021 strike. We went ahead with the agitations and for the first time in the history, AINBOF conducted a strike on its own during March 2021 against Privatisation and other issues like Updation of pension to the retirees.

It is pertinent to mention here that many of the banking policies and decisions of the Union Government are directly affecting the nationalized banks & its officers only and thus the very presence of STRONG AINBOF – an exclusive Federation to guard the interest of the work force of Nationalized Banks is much needed at this juncture. With the continuous propaganda on privatization of two public sector banks, the Government is employing a ploy keeping everyone concerned guessing and creating despair and exasperation in their minds.

It is the duty of every one of us not to fall prey to these devious tactics and remain committed to our opposition to privatization and achieve the goal in the interest of the country's economic growth and public welfare.

It would be possible for the organization like AINBOF only which is meant exclusively for the welfare and presence of PSBs and it's workforce to fight consistently against the Privatisation move.

I have been serving as the General secretary of this great organisation and I have been true to the spirit and objectives of AINBOF throughout and now, I am handing over the mantle of leading AINBOF to **Com. Sanjay Das, A PROVEN COMMITTED CHARISMATIC LEADER RELENTLESSLY FIGHTING FOR UPHOLDING THE PRINCIPLES OF NATIONALISATION AND THE WELFARE OF BANK OFFICERS** who is also the President of FBOIOA to steer the federation to greater glory in the coming days .

I am confident that he will guard the essence and spirit of the federation for which we were fighting for long, carry forward its battles and bring laurels to the organisation and nationalized bank officers.

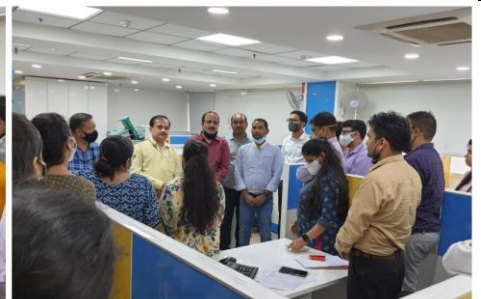
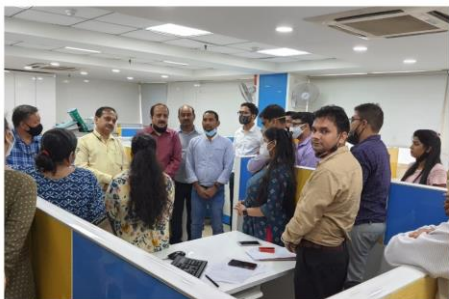

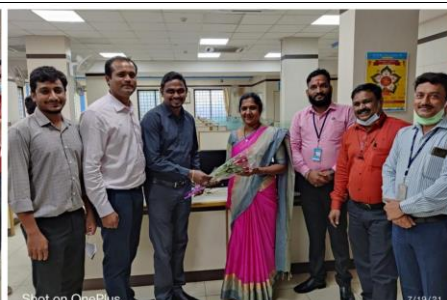
